OUR MISSION

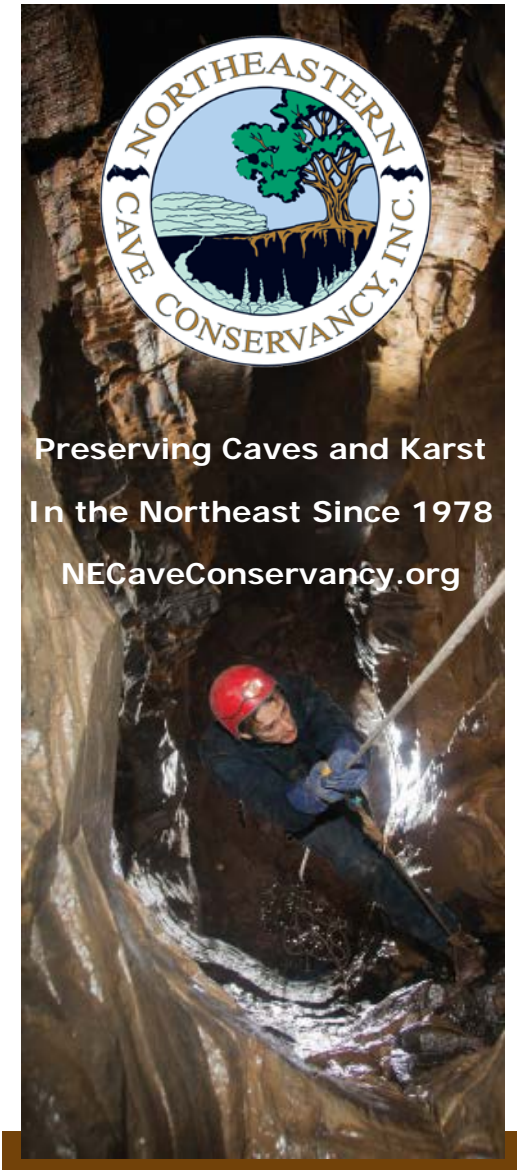
